E | LLIPSE [e-lips], n. Geometrical form, a conic section. The ellipse features prominently in the design of the MINI – in the headlights, door handles, and interior door cladding and storage compartments. The door cladding matches the standard upholstery materials, while the door handle is painted in anthracite. Where leather or fabric/leather combinations are specified, the door is upholstered to match, and the contoured edging is painted silver. The armrest is always upholstered in black leather, regardless of the material chosen for the seats.

STYLE [stile], n. A set of distinguishing characteristics.


Every line, surface, colour and material in the MINI conveys a unique combination of quality and distinctiveness that appeals to all the senses: the look of the seat designs and colours, the feel of the chrome-plated surfaces, and the rich sound of the engine. All of these >> design features combine to make driving the MINI a very special experience.





DASH | BOARD [dash-bord], n. An instrument panel. The MINI's ergonomically designed dashboard incorporates a tachometer, a rev counter (in the case of the MINI Cooper), and four circular air vents. Finished as standard with two coats of high-gloss anthracite paint; high-gloss silver or aluminium finishes are available as an optional extra.



GO-KART [gō-kārt], n. A low, compact racing vehicle. The MINI's handling is similar to that of a go-kart, mainly because of the gear lever, which allows rapid, easy gear changes, and the extremely precise steering. There are two choices of steering wheel: a structured composite two-spoke version as standard, or a leather-covered version as an optional extra.



NOTE | PAD [not-pad], mine. I always keep it in the glove compartment of my MINI Cooper. I use it to write down all the ideas I have while I'm driving, like the title of a seminar (though this still needs a bit of a rethink), the draft of my speech at the philologists' conference in Rome (this will blow them away!) and a recipe for salmon in champagne sauce (très bon!).



TACH | O | MET | ER [tak-ō-mi-tər], n. An instrument for measuring the velocity of machines. In the MINI it's large, round, and centrally positioned on the dashboard. It's easy to read and gives you information about various systems, such as the ABS function. It incorporates fuel and temperature gauges, and also gives you other important information: for example, it warns you when the tyre pressure is low. The rev counter is fitted as standard on the MINI Cooper. It is located above the steering column and, like the steering wheel itself, its height can be adjusted.



LUX | U | RY [luk'sha-ri]. Abundant provision of comfort and ease over and above what is normal. In the MINI One and MINI Cooper every detail is a perfect marriage of style and practicality. For example, on the central console, chrome rocker switches operate the electric windows, DSC and ASC + T driver aids, central locking, fog lamps and rear lights.


EA | SY AC | CESS [ēzee-ak'ses], n. The MINI's two front seats slide and tilt forward for easy access to the rear seats. Locking them back into their original positions is simplicity itself: just pull the seat forward and fold up the backrest. The height of the driver's seat can also be adjusted.

Maybe they're in the left-hand door pocket, maybe on the right-hand side or maybe even in the boot – but my favourite strawberry sweeties are definitely lying around somewhere. It's the little things that tell you if someone has style or not.





The MINI's luggage space varies between 150 and 670 litres; the rear seats can be folded down individually to make room for large loads, the rear parcel shelf is easily stowed away, and for smaller objects there is a compartment in the floor of the boot. All floors are luxuriously carpeted.





EN | CY | CLO | PE | DI | A [en-si-klō-pē'di-ə], mine. I keep all 20 volumes in the boot, just in case. If I fold down the rear seats, I can fit in my whole collection of antique 16th and 17th-century books. (Not that the collection is small – it's because the MINI is so big!)

FROM A TO X: WHAT MAKES THE MINI AND THE MINI COOPER SO SAFE.

ABS with CBC: Anti-lock Braking System with Cornering Brake Control. Control systems fitted as standard which improve braking (ABS), especially in

corners (CBC) and prevent understeer.

Airbags: Two front airbags fitted as standard, which detect the severity of a crash and inflate to the level needed to maximize protection, and

two side airbags for driver and passenger. Head airbags can be specified front and rear as an option.

Automatic seat belts: Three-point belts as standard on all four seats, with pyrotechnic belt tensioners and belt force limiters in the front.

Automatic Stability Regulates engine output when pulling away or accelerating hard into corners, applies braking to drive wheels and prevents wheel spin.

Available as an optional extra.

Bodywork: With extreme torsional and flexional rigidity. The Euro NCAP crash test awarded the MINI four stars – an outstanding result.

Disc brakes: As standard, internally ventilated.

DSC: Dynamic Stability Control. Maintains vehicle stability by intervening in the application of power and/or braking force to all four wheels.

Available as an optional extra.

EBD: Regulates the Electronic Braking Force Distribution between the front and rear axles.

Rain sensor: Matches the interval of windscreen wiper movements to the intensity of rainfall. Available as an optional extra.

Tyre Defect Indicator: Fitted as standard. Warns driver of any loss of tyre pressure, meaning the majority of impending tyre failures can be identified in good

time.

Control (ASC+T):

Xenon lights: High-intensity lights, with outstanding illumination of peripheral areas. Available as an optional extra.

Luca Marinelli lives in a little village, about an hour's drive south-east of Bologna. He grew up here and came back "after my father died". Now in his mid-fifties and already a grandfather, Marinelli nevertheless still has the physique and firm handshake of a middleweight boxer.



For many years, it was impossible to tell him apart from his employees; he mostly wore blue jeans and black polo shirts. But these days he occasionally takes his jacket out of the wardrobe – when it suits him. "Yes, of course appearances matter to me," he confesses. "I label every bottle by hand."

However, he still spends most of his time in his olive groves. Every morning he goes out very early. Often with his Uncle Mateo but more often alone – in his MINI One, with real wood dash trim and leather seats. By the time he arrives home, the lights in the family home are usually already on.



The large tachometer, which is centrally positioned on the dashboard, incorporates a liquid crystal display for mileage and trip counters. This is also where you'll find the warning lights for fuel level, indicators, oil pressure, full beam etc.

The service interval display tells you when the car is due for its next oil change and service; a digital countdown display in the tachometer dial tells you how far there is to go before your next service.




















The Dynamic Stability Control (DSC) system detects potential skids right at the outset and stabilises the car within milliseconds.









The remote-controlled alarm system is activated by any break-in attempt or tampering with the car, sounding an alarm and switching the hazard lights on at the same time.









In November '72 the pickers came and plucked the just-ripening fruits from the trees. Within 24 hours the first olives had been ground, pressed, filtered and bottled. Marinelli was excited about the result. "I still remember it as if it were yesterday. I sprinkled some oil on a hot potato, examined the colour and breathed in the smell." "I pay great attention to detail. I chose the different components of the car myself. I was looking for something that not everyone has got, and I found it."

The one-time boxer and current landowner will defend his title year after year against all comers. "I'll never give up the DOP seal of quality without a hell of a fight. Just as I won't give up my MINI One."



Information: Extra virgin olive oil.

Two of the most important criteria by which an olive oil is judged are acidity and taste. Pure olive oil should contain a maximum of 1 % unsaturated fatty acids. The most common aromas in the bouquet of olive oil are freshly mown grass, tomatoes, artichokes, almonds and apples.

Olive oil is sensitive to light and heat and should therefore be stored in a cool dark place (at between 14 and 20°C), though it can also be kept in a domestic fridge. This can give it a cloudy appearance, but it quickly regains its clarity at room temperature and quality is not affected. It can be stored in the fridge for up to two years, depending on the best before date.








